

UNSAFE DRIVING POLICY

Proficient Auto Transport is committed to ensuring that we not only deliver vehicles on time and damage-free, but we also are committed to safe driving. Therefore, we are adopting a new policy to ensure that we are meeting the DOT regulations and maintaining a positive CSA Score. Currently, our CSA is unacceptable, and we need to take immediate action to lower our score. Having a high score puts you, the driver, at a higher risk of being pulled over and inspected. It also puts the company at risk of being audited. Our customers hold us accountable to maintain a low CSA Score. It is important to always drive at the posted speed limit, avoid tailgating, stay in the correct lane, and yield the right-of-way to emergency vehicles. A written warning by a DOT officer is the same as a ticket, except you cannot contest a warning. Anyone who receives a citation, must notify the Safety Department immediately and try to fight the ticket.

- Speeding 6-10 mph over the posted speed limit: **3-day suspension.**
- Speeding 11-14 mph over the posted speed limit: **5-day suspension.**
- Speeding 15+ mph over the posted speed limit: **Termination, pending final court decision.**

In addition to speeding, the violations listed below are also under the SMS Basic "unsafe driving" and may result in disciplinary action up to possible termination.

- Lane restriction violation
- Tailgating
- Failure to obey traffic control device.
- Improper turns
- Failure to use seat belt.
- Using a hand-held mobile telephone
- Failure to yield right of way.
- Unauthorized passenger on board a CMV
